Road Improvement Project / Carr Road from M-46 (Apple Avenue) and Hall Road, Egelston

Township, Muskegon County

The Muskegon County Road Commission has scheduled a local road improvement project on Carr Road from M-46 (Apple Avenue) to Hall Road in Egelston Township, Muskegon County, Michigan.

Work will begin on Monday, October 7, 2024 and will last approximately two (2) weeks, weather permitting.

The one-mile project will consist of hot mix asphalt base crushing, shaping and resurfacing, gravel shoulders and pavement markings on Carr Road from M-46 (Apple Avenue) to Hall Road.

Due to the scope of work Carr Road will be closed to all traffic at Apple Avenue. Non-local traffic must follow the signed detour and/or seek alternate routes. Local traffic is advised to enter/exit Carr Road from Hall Road. The detour consists of Hall Road, Brooks Road, and Apple Avenue, see attached map.

If you have any critical health condition or other special condition, which you feel we should be made aware of, please feel free to contact the Muskegon County Road Commission.

If mailboxes need to be temporarily relocated you will be contacted by the Muskegon County Road Commission.

We are hoping this letter will allow you time to prepare for this upcoming project and plan for any particular needs/concerns you may have.
