
Would you like to see a farmers market in Egelston?



Would you like to see a community center in Egelston?




Answers to Question 12:



- 1) At Holiday Park, the girl's ballfield really needs some shade. Please plant some trees by the stands. It's very hard to watch a game in the backfield. Something needs to be done to improve this field.
- 2) Ours is a great community, thanks for asking!
- 3) Would like a Community Center that could be useable than the pavilion shown. Build it in a central location, such as Apple Ave.
- 4) It would be nice if Pine Ridge Park was more than just a sledding hill and woods, like disc golf. My son plays and has to go 10 miles to the nearest park. It keeps kids, adults, and families active, outdoors, and enjoying the woods. It's an inexpensive activity to enjoy, too.
- 5) We need more softball fields. We are getting more youth teams and nowhere for all the kids to practice/play games.
- 6) Widen the Wolf Lake boat launch.
- 7) I'm interested to hear what sports field the pavilion will to be on. There are 3 sports fields and a court located there. Poor word choice was used in the survey. It would have helped to make the survey clearer for the person taking the survey. I hope the P.C. can make a diagram of the possible options of where the pavilion will be or where it is being considered.
- 8) I applaud the efforts of trying to get feedback for the above issues. There are too many additional questions and results in the questionnaire. Hopefully, all the results will be made available. First, the costs of items. Grant monies are great, but, matching funds are usually needed. Take the pavilion, for example. Basically, it will go unused for 75% of the year. It will probably be used only on weekends from mid-May through August. Is this the best use of our money? Creating new playing fields can be done overnight and Holiday Park's fields are used 5 days a week from April through July. Would these fields be used primarily for softball and /or soccer practice? Appreciate the initiative. Thank you.
- 9) We need to use our lake and lake front area more.
- 10) Pavilions should have metal roofs and vinyl siding installed on them for better appearance and durability.
- 11) Make upgrades to Holiday Park.
- 12) Holiday Park is overlooked by many and needs to have more publicity. Please put the pavilion at Holiday Park. It is more open and can be better used.
- 13) The bike or multi-use path that runs along Apple Ave., needs to be fixed. I cannot ride my bike down the path because it's not safe. I have blown 2 tires riding on it because the path is not properly graded at the crossings. Tires cost \$225.00 a piece, so please don't discount my opinion because you don't agree with me paying that much for a bike tire. I commute on my bike, so I use the Apple Ave. path, that is my choice, or if I use the path along side of it, I will risk damaging my property.
- 14) Need to add soccer fields at Holiday Park.
- 15) In question #5, why would I pay \$100.00 of the pavilion for the whole day, when I can rent the pavilion at Duck Lake State Park for only \$50.00 a day. Question #1 or #2 will not allow you to mark more than one, so you're not getting an accurate figure on park usage. Flickema Park pavilion should be a rental, too. Put a bocce ball court at Beals Park and there should be food stations at all the Township parks.
- 16) Expanding the sports field at Holiday Park would greatly benefit our youth. There is an incredible need for space for our kids to find a safe area to play.
- 17) The pavilion, as stated in the rendering, is restrooms and storage, NOT a community center and useable in the winter. I would not support that at this time.

- 18) The festival is near and dear to my heart. I'm down with making it better. Why Holiday Park? Totally open to change. Just not sure why however. Still could have activities at both places. How about a community clean-up day. Or pick one property a year that could use some financial help cleaning their yard or getting a roof to replace a blue tarp.



Would you like to see a pavilion like this in one of our parks?


